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About ASU Prep Global Academy

Arizona State University has partnered with ASU Preparatory Academy to create the ASU Prep Global Academy, where online 6-12 and university courses converge in a unique learning opportunity for all students. Unique to the program, Global Academy is integrated with the university, with more than 200 pathways into the disciplines that give students direct access to university faculty and major-level courses in high school. Throughout their 6-12 experience, students can choose to become part of a college-going and college attending community, thus providing familiarity, confidence, and a pathway to post secondary success.

ASU Prep Global Academy is the private school option available through ASU Preparatory Academy, an innovative and thriving charter school network located in Arizona. As a public school network, ASU Preparatory Academy serves Arizona students at seven campuses in Arizona, and through ASU Prep Digital, a full-time public charter school for Arizona residents. Global Academy aims to provide the same robust, fully virtual educational program as a private school for students nationally and internationally. We are proudly accredited by Cognia, and most of our course options are NCAA and California A-G approved.

Mission and Purpose

ASU Prep Global Academy implements innovative education to empower students. Our mission is to design new models for educational success and to raise academic achievement for all learners. We are committed to ASU's core values of excellence, access, and impact in everything we do. We measure ourselves by the outcomes our students achieve, the accomplishments of our graduates, our contributions to the public good and by the economic, social, and cultural vitality of the communities that surround us.

Academic Program

ASU Prep Global Academy combines online high school and university courses, giving students the opportunity to earn college credit along with their high school diploma. This international online school offers college-prep curriculum, passionate online teachers, university professors and personal Learning Specialists. Global Academy partners with U.S. and international students and schools to offer single course enrollments and full-time, diploma-granting programs.

Unique to our program, Global Academy's curriculum integrates with the university to build learning pathways into the disciplines, allowing students to access faculty and major level courses while in high school. Likewise, Global Academy proactively seeks and secures university resources to integrate into the high school program and curriculum.

Credit Requirements

Global Academy at ASU Prep is designed to provide a wholly unique pathway to graduation for all students, whether that is an expedited graduation from traditional timelines or seeking to catch up on credit deficiencies. All students must earn no fewer than 25% of their credits earned through ASU Preparatory Academy. In order to be considered for first-year, full-time admission to most U.S. colleges and universities, Global Academy enforces the following minimum requirements:

- 4 credits math
- 4 credits English (non-ESL/ELL courses)
- 3 credits lab sciences (1 year each from biology, chemistry, earth science, integrated sciences, or physics)
- 2 credits social sciences (including 1 year American history)
- 2 credits same second language (includes American Sign Language)
- 1 credit fine arts or career and technical education
- 1 credit health, physical education, or health science

Grading and Ranking

School policy does not allow for individual ranking and instead ranks students based on grade point average percentage in the class; GPA for Summa Cum Laude - 3.8+; GPA for Magna Cum Laude - 3.6 to 3.79; GPA for Cum Laude - 3.4 to 3.59.

GPA is calculated based on adding all points earned and dividing the total points by the total number of courses taken. All grades earned from credit-earning, high-school level courses count toward their cumulative GPA. Honors and dual-enrollment courses are awarded an extra grade point for a grade of A, B, C, up to a maximum of 5 points.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a bespoke schedule. Six classes is the typical course load at a given time, with a recommendation of no more than eight classes at a given time. Students who complete a half-credit course are eligible to take more courses. Students may accelerate and complete a course at any time. There is a minimum 14-calendar-day seat-time requirement. Students work an average of 3-4 hours per course weekly. Students may attend live learning sessions and complete coursework at any time throughout the week. Live learning sessions are held Monday through Friday, but students may request additional teacher contact as needed.
